City of Nine Springs Modified Request for Feasibility Study Determination

Dear Mr. Nelson,

On January 12, 2026, The Office of the Lieutenant Governor (OLG) received a Modified Request for Feasibility Study (“Modified Request”) relating to the proposed City of Nine Springs (preliminary municipality) as described in UCA §10-2a-505. In accordance with UCA §10-2a-505 and §10-2a-503 the OLG determined that the Modified Request does not comply with UCA §10-2a-505(1)(a), as the request does not indicate that the sponsors modified their initial request “to alter the boundaries of the proposed municipality area” 10-2a-505(1)(a). Inasmuch as the boundaries of the proposed city remain unaltered on your Modified Request, the submission does not meet the statutory requirements and cannot be accepted.

As outlined in UCA §10-2a-505(3), the sponsors “may not file a modified feasibility request under Subsection (1)(a)(i) more than once.” Because the Modified Feasibility Request does not comply with Utah Code §10-2a-505(1)(a), the incorporation process cannot proceed.
